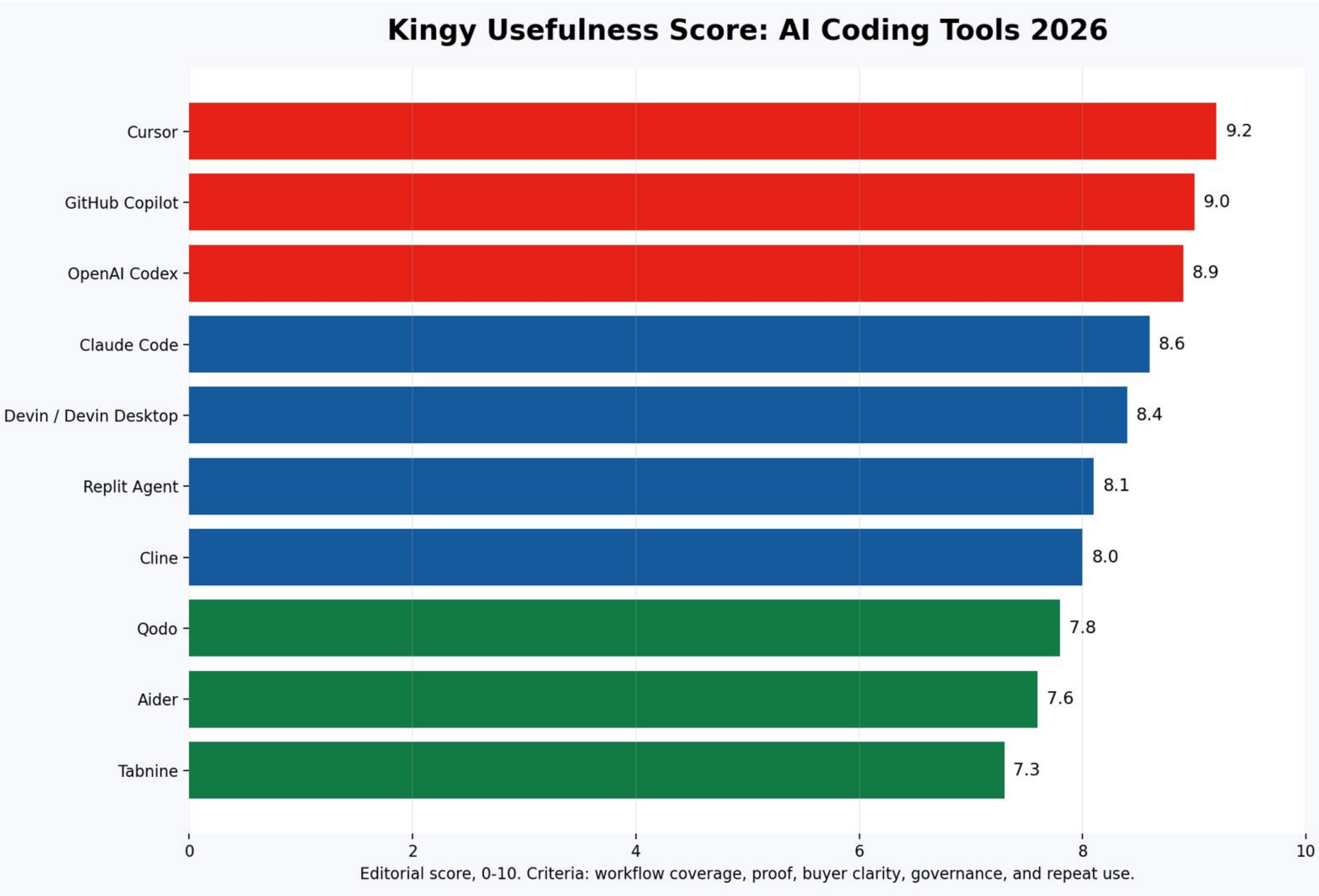

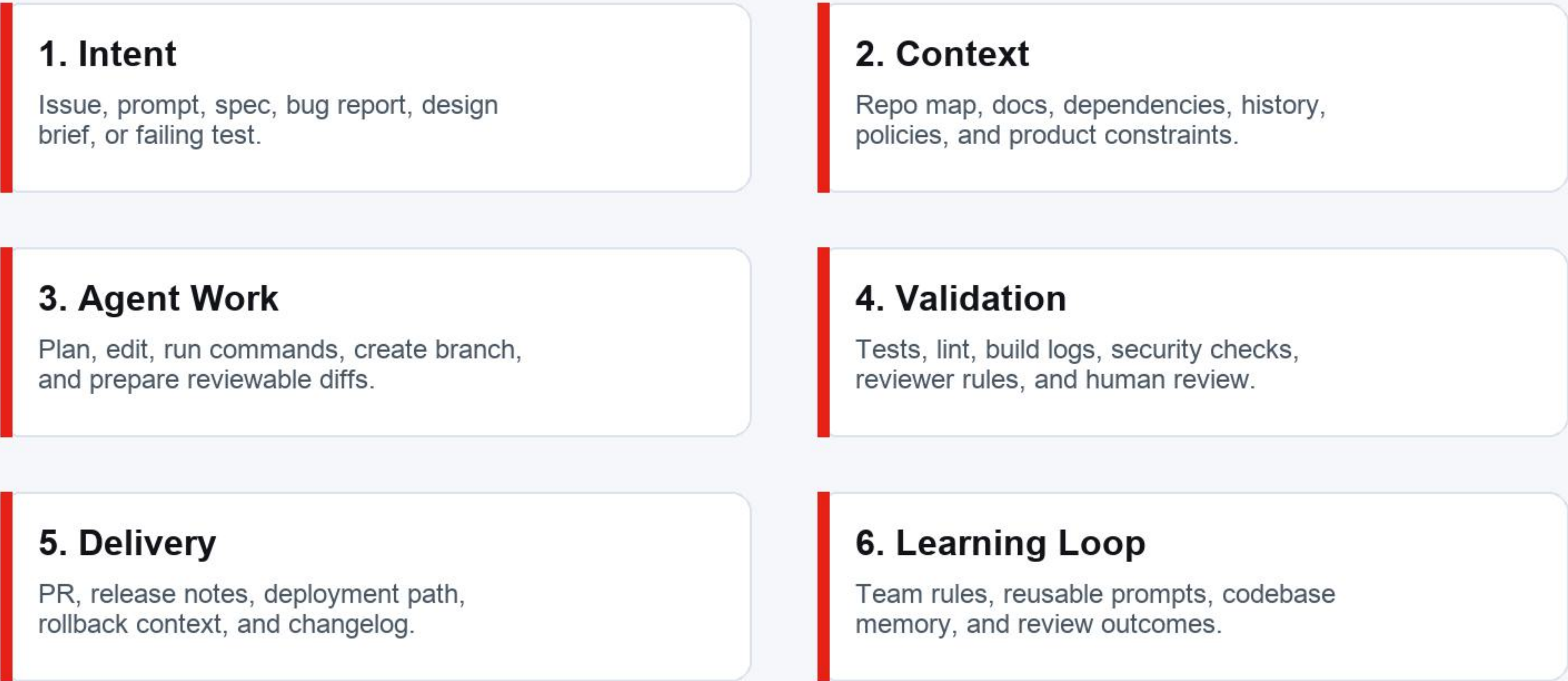

The market is expanding from autocomplete into an end-to-end developer operating layer.



Agent Maturity Matrix

A practical scoring lens for judging whether a coding agent is demo-good or workflow-ready.

Demo Layer Can generate a file, explain a change, or scaffold a small app.	Repo Layer Understands multi-file context and follows local project conventions.
Validation Layer Runs tests, interprets failures, and makes smaller reviewable changes.	Team Layer Works with PRs, permissions, rules, audit trails, and human review gates.
Automation Layer Handles repeat chores such as CI fixes, dependency updates, and docs.	Governance Layer Supports policy, privacy, security posture, and enterprise controls.
